A LUBBE NO AND OTHERS v MILLENNIUM STYLE (PTY) LTD

The SCA dismissed this appeal with costs. The case concerned the validity of trade mark registrations and their infringement. The trade marks were supposed to be devices to be applied to shoe sales but were found to be an attempt to register shapes. The SCA also found that the trade marks were inherently not capable of distinguishing.

The court expressed its displeasure about the ease with which “trade marks” are registered and the use of the register for ulterior purposes.
